Esa 07 is a table lamp with a timeless elegance. The glossy blown glass diffuser with an ellipsoidal base is white on the inside to reflect light, and it is available in white and ivory on the outside, which are two neutral colours that adapt to a multitude of styles and diffuse an intense and warm light in all directions. Available in two sizes to adapt to a variety of uses, the diffuser of the small version closes completely at the top, becoming a single whole. The diffuser of the large version is instead fitted with an opaline screen to avoid glare.

The glossy aluminium support recalls the soft shape of the diffuser: the rod is curved and is secured to an ellipsoidal base that does not close completely.

Description:

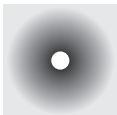
Table lamp with diffused light. Hand-blown glass diffuser with glossy finish, white on the inside and coloured on the outside, using a "stationary" glass-blowing technique without turning the glass in the mould. Die cast aluminium base, hand finished and polished. For the large version, upper diffuser screen in opaline glare-proof PMMA, ON/OFF switch on the transparent cable. For the small version, dimmer fitted on the transparent cable to adjust the brightness gradually.

Materials: blown glass and polished aluminium

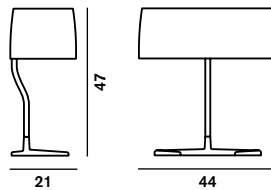
