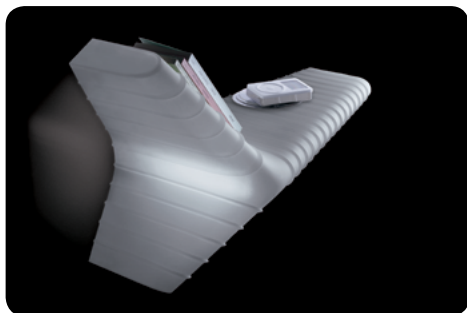

The modular wall lamp Yet, designed by Studio Kairos, does double duty as a wall-mounted lighting appliance and, at the same time, as a modular shelf.

The particular Y shape of Yet is designed to exploit the light of a simple fluorescent bulb all over its surface. Infinite compositions can be obtained by combining multiple Yets, also using diffusers of different colours: white, yellow or grey.

Description

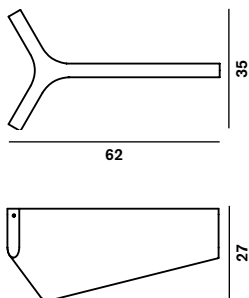
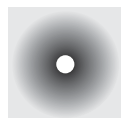
Wall lamp with semi-diffused and reflected light. The satin finish coloured polycarbonate diffuser is injection moulded. Can be used as a storage shelf with a maximum load of 20kg distributed evenly. The end caps allow for the passage of an electrical cable for multiple configurations powered by a single power point. Wall mounting plate in epoxy powder coated metal, electronic ballast.

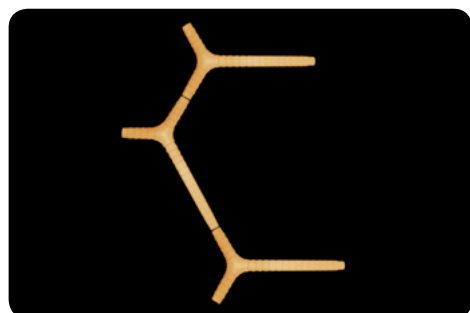
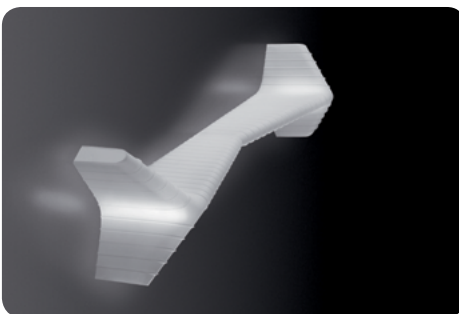
